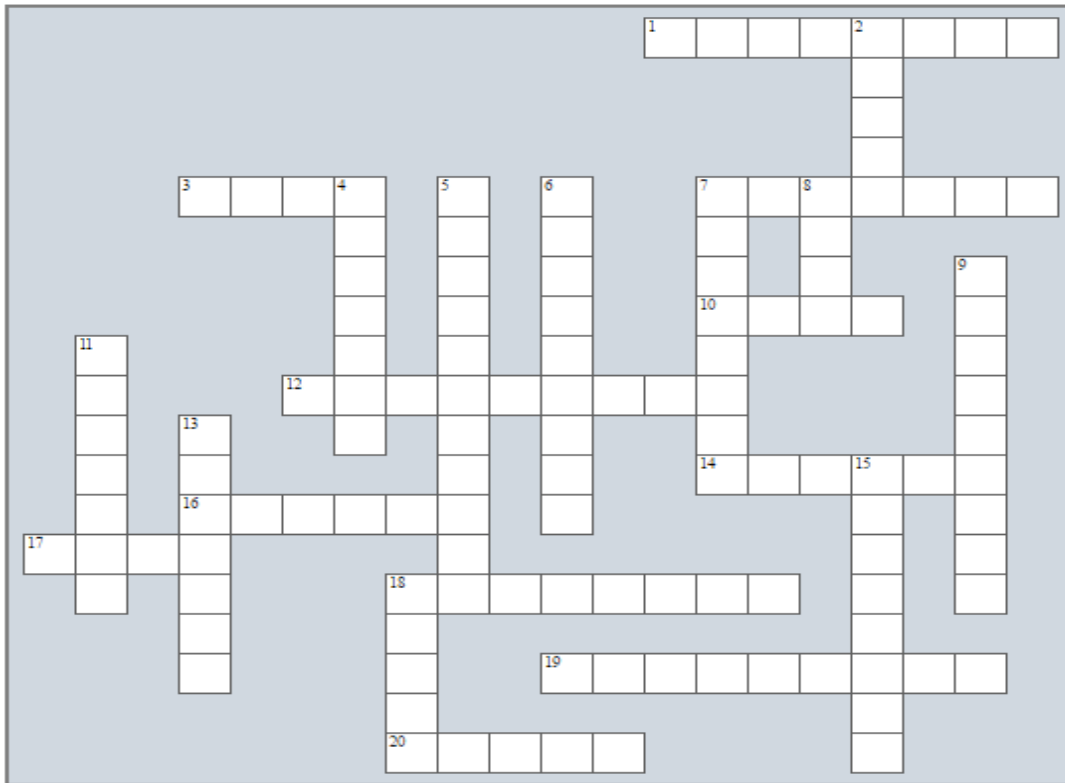


## Matthew 10:26-33
